According to the annual Voluntary Support of Education (VSE) survey, conducted by the Council for Aid to Education, charitable contributions to colleges and universities in the United States increased 9% in 2013. The \$33.80 billion total is the highest recorded in the history of the survey. In 2009, giving fell from \$31.60 billion, which was then the historical high point, to \$27.85 billion. Giving

In addition, the survey revealed interesting behavior in alumni giving and alumni participation. While alumni giving increased by 16.9%, total alumni participation declined to 8.7% last year. What could be the reason for this variance? Although the number of donors compared to number of alumni went down, higher levels of giving among capable, contributing alumni offset this decline, leading to the increase in alumni giving overall.
